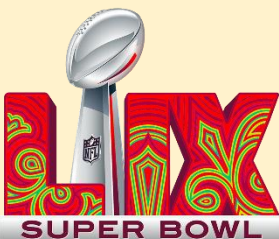
A pancake breakfast was served to the participating youth and their families. Certificates were presented to the winners of each age group.

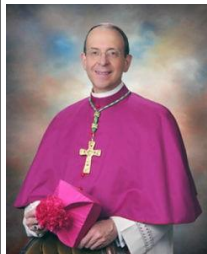

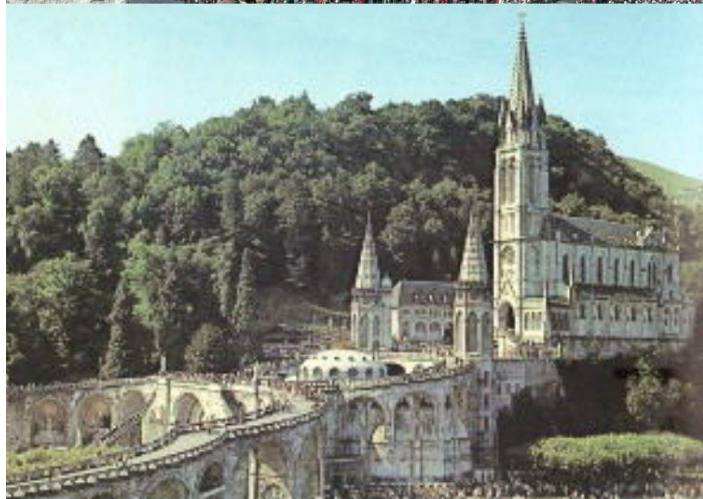
