Brothers in Christ,

This month we will observe the three holy days, Triduum. The more technical term for Holy Week is the "paschal triduum" or "Easter triduum.". The Triduum begins on

the evening of Holy Thursday, continues through Good Friday and Holy Saturday, and concludes on Easter Sunday. Each of these days has its own significance:

**Holy Thursday** — the church commemorates Christ's Passover meal with his apostles. The Mass of the Lord's Supper most especially remembers the institution of the Eucharist.

**Good Friday** – the church emphasizes the passion of Christ. We recall Jesus' suffering and death on the cross. There is a communion service, but no Mass on this day. Veneration of the cross is a part of the observance.

**Holy Saturday** – The Easter Vigil begins at night. It starts with a fire, which is blessed, and from which is lit the paschal candle. The whole of salvation history is proclaimed during the readings. It is also on this day that catechumens from the OCIA program are baptized and confirmed into the church.

**Easter Sunday** – is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead. His resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. We celebrate that God's promise of redemption have been fulfilled through his Son, Jesus Christ.

Then the angel said to the women in reply, "Do not be afraid! I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay." (*Matt 28:5-6*)

#### Supreme Chaplain's Challenge (April)

A monthly reflection and practical challenge from Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori



She said to him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." (Gospel for April 6, Jn 11:27)

These words belong to Martha, sister of Lazarus, as she and Jesus speak outside her brother's tomb. Her choice of words is important: "I have come to believe." This suggests her belief has evolved, that her

previous uncertainty or ignorance about Jesus has blossomed into faith. Growing in faith is usually a process of moving from questioning or doubt to illumination and trust. How do we come to faith and then grow deeper in it? We do so through prayer, study and reflection. Let us continually deepen our faith in this manner.

This month, I challenge you to take part in a Catholic faith formation course, event or opportunity offered through your local council (such as Cor), your parish or diocese, or online.

- Looking at the development of your own faith, how have you "come to believe" truths about Christ and/or the
- What teachings do you still have questions about? What areas of your faith would you like to develop further?




