





Born in Western Massachusetts and entered St. Albert Seminary in 1955. First Profession as a Carmelite was in 1958. After Theology studies in Rome, Fr. He has devoted much of his priesthood to the major renewal movement in the Church, such as Marriage Encounter, Cursillo and the Charismatic Renewal. Now Retired, Fr. For betting purposes <u>only</u> and <u>prior</u> to each race, USD (\$) will need to be exchanged for "Funny Money" Tickets in \$2 increments at **Cashier's Table**.

There is no betting limit. You can place a bet at the Betting Window Table with as many \$2 tickets as you like. Please refer to the Horse Number rather than the Horse Name when placing your bet.

The **Betting Window Table** will be open for approximately **15 minutes prior to each race** and closed just before the race start time.

After each race, the official Order of Finish will be announced. Winner payoff amounts are then calculated and announced. Those holding winning tickets can then redeem them at the Cashier's Table.

Following the Kentucky Derby and the subsequent 10 DVD races, there will be an **Owner's Auction** where the 10 DVD race winning horses will be auctioned off. This will be followed by the Owner's Auction Race. Above race rules apply.

Please note that unlike the Kentucky Derby, post position slots for all DVD races are assigned by a random number selector program and do not reflect past race performance.
