





The purpose of the Mary Lives Ministry is to help young people develop spiritual growth by learning the power of daily recitation of the Holy Rosary and how this practice will help build a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ.

Brother Sesso stated that there are number of powerful videos focused on the Blessed Mother that are embedded in the website. There is also a webpage dedicated to various Marian apparitions with accompanying videos. There is even a link to the 1943 movie, "The Song of Bernadette". The movie tells the story of the apparitions of Mary to Saint Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. The apparitions took place in Lourdes, France.



The Knights of Columbus Charitable Fund (KCCF) provides a Council Account specially tailored for a state or local Knights of Columbus Council to maximize its ability to provide charitable support to organizations and causes within its community or to the Order's Faith in Action initiatives. Monetary contributions to a KCCF account are counted as donations to a 501(c)(3) organization. Section 501(c)(3) is a portion of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and a specific tax category for nonprofit organizations. Organizations that meet Section 501(c)(3) requirements are exempt from federal income tax. The Order maintains a list of approved 501(c)(3) organizations that align with Catholic values of preserving and promoting human life and dignity. Charities that are not currently listed can be added, after a vetting process, should a council want to make a donation to that organization.

Notre Dame Council 10514 has established two KCCF council accounts:

Notre Dame Council 10514 General Donations: Donations made to this KCCF account are used for various Faith in Action programs such as support for Church or Diocesan projects or initiatives, Santa Maria del Mar Youth 5K Run, Santa Maria del Mar Bread of Life Ministry, Religious Vocation support, etc.

KCCF Council 10514 Online General Donation Link

Notre Dame Council 10514 Pro-Life Restricted Donations: Donations made to this KCCF are used specifically for support of Pro-Life charitable causes. e.g. Purchase of an ultrasound machine, Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP) programs, Purchase and installation of a Safe Haven Baby Box, qualified organizations that support citizens with disabilities, etc.

KCCF Council 10514 Online Pro-Life Restricted Donation Link

Donations made to KCCF accounts may be tax deductible*. If you are eligible, Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) transfers can also be accepted. All monies from a Notre Dame Council 10514 KCCF account can only be distributed to a 501(c)(3) organization.

Notre Dame Council conducts fundraisers throughout the year. The KCCF accounts can be utilized to hold net proceeds until it is time to make a distribution. This allows the opportunity for the funds to grow prior to disbursement.

Direct donations can be made by individuals by clicking on either of the links above. You may also utilize either of the QR codes from the photo app on your phone or smart device.

He will furnish you with the Knights of Columbus Charitable Fund Donation Agreement form needed as well as the instructions on how to submit the funds directly to the Supreme Council office for deposit into the council's KCCF account.




Prayer for the Healing of Loved Ones


