Brothers in Christ,

On June 24<sup>th</sup> we will celebrate the Feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. The feast day is exactly six months before Christmas. ***"And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God."*** (Luke 1:36-37). It also reflects the cosmic liturgical order, aligning John's birth with the summer solstice. During this time, days begin to shorten. As St. Augustine noted, this decline mirrors John's words: ***"He must increase, but I must decrease"*** (John 3:30), reflecting his mission's humility. The feast day is also three months after the Feast of the Annunciation on March 25<sup>th</sup>.

Only two saints in the church have feast days commemorating their birth, the Blessed Mother and St. John the Baptist. This is due to the uniqueness of their birth. Every Catholic is aware of the dogma that the Blessed

Mother was conceived without sin and free from the stain of original sin. St. John the Baptist was sanctified in the womb. He is the first person to adore the Savior of the World: ***"When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb..."*** (Luke 1:41)

You have heard me say on numerous occasions that everything about the Catholic Church is biblical. I ask that this month you take time to read and reflect on the many mysteries found in the first chapter of the gospel of St. Luke. Know your faith. Imitate the life of St. John the Baptist and live a life of repentance. Let us recall his words: ***"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"*** (Matthew 3:2)

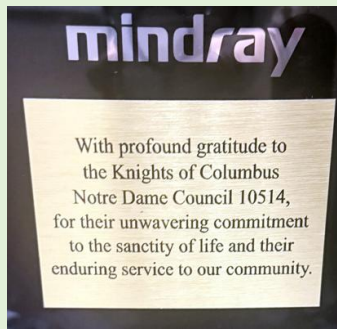

Executive Director Nancy Basham stated that thirty-eight unborn children have been saved so far in 2026. She related one story in particular where a young nineteen-year-old woman came in certain that she wanted an

abortion. She had the ultrasound and listened to the staff explain the free resources that were available to her. She left the center and the staff were concerned that she would proceed with the abortion. The young mom-to-be returned two months later and asked what she needed to do to sign up for parenting classes. When asked what changed her mind, she stated: "I could not get the picture of my baby in the ultrasound out of my mind. I knew that I wanted to keep and raise by baby."

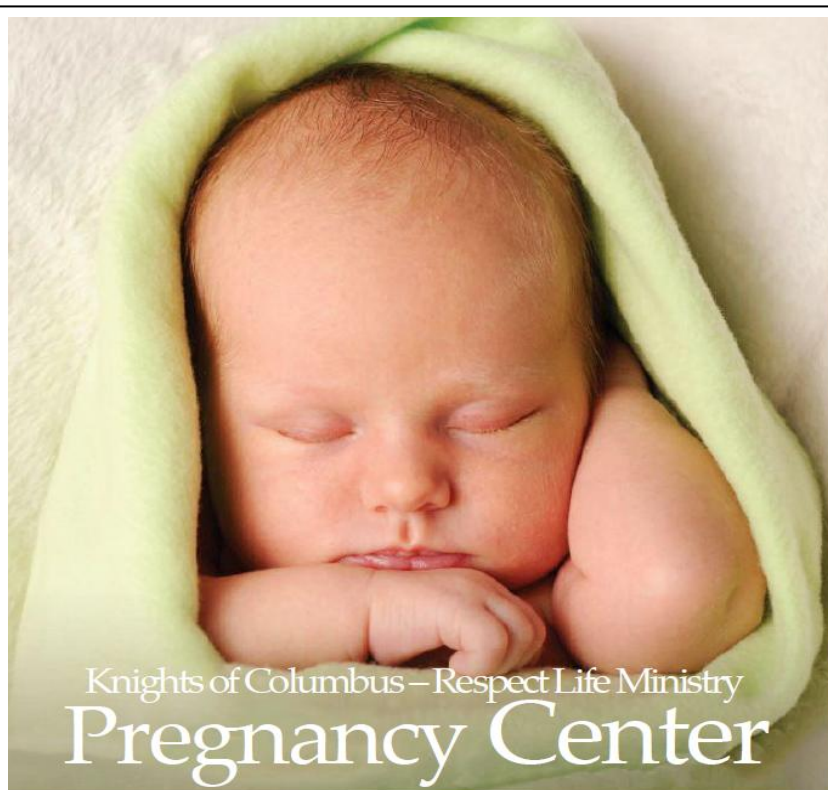

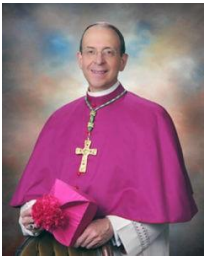

**“[W]hoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.” (Gospel for June 28, Mt 10:38)**

Our fallen human condition involves a measure of suffering and trials. Our commitment as disciples of Jesus, Scripture tells us, necessarily means taking up our own crosses willingly. God will grant us the strength to endure all trials if we remain faithful, and our suffering can prove redemptive if we accept it and unite it to the passion of Christ. This doesn't mean we can't take steps to alleviate our suffering, but we are called to courageously bear our crosses,

even when faced with persecution, and to thereby participate in the saving work of Christ.

This month, I challenge you to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet each day with the intention of uniting your daily sufferings with Christ's passion and in solidarity with all persecuted Christians around the world.

### Questions for Reflection:

- Do you carry your cross willingly, or do you feel it is forced upon you?

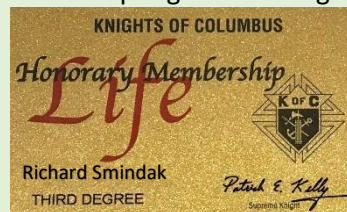
## Honorary Life Status Achieved

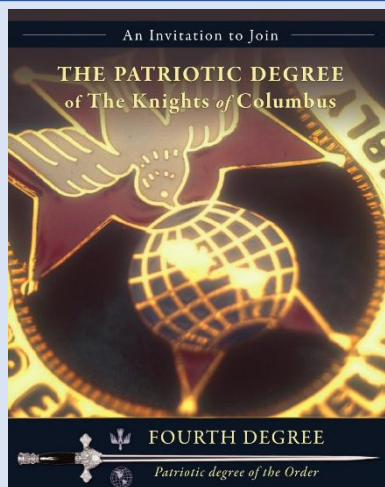
Brother Smindak was just elected as the Council 10514's Warden for the 2026-27 fraternal year. He also is an active member of the BINGO committee.
