The Church celebrates the Feast of the Archangels on September 29th. It is sometimes referred to as 'Michaelmas' (Michael's Mass) after the Archangel Michael.

The Bible mentions three archangels by name:
St Michael - whose name means "Who is like God?"
St Gabriel - whose name means "Strength of God"
St Raphael - whose name means "God's Healing"

The archangels are among the nine choirs of angels. They can be great intercessors for the faithful. We pray for St Michael's intercession in times of temptation and spiritual battle. The Bible says that it is St. Michael that led the

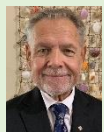

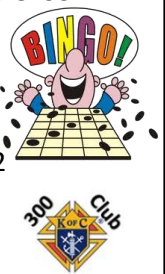

Field Agent – Larry Kennedy “Fraternal Benefits”

When Father McGivney founded our Order, a key part of his mission was to help Catholic families attain a secure financial future. In keeping with that mission, Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly recently announced updates to our member benefits.

Whether or not you are an insured Knight of Columbus, you are entitled to the Member/Spouse Fraternal Benefit. This is an accidental death benefit varies from \$1,500-\$5,000, depending on your age, whether you are insured and how long you've been a member.

The other updates I'd like to call out apply to insured members:

Family Fraternal Benefit: It's guaranteed-issue insurance up to \$10,000 to any child under age 18, regardless of physical or intellectual disabilities. This also includes an automatic \$5,000 death benefit for children who die before age 61 days, including stillbirths from at least 20 weeks after conception.

Orphan Fraternal Benefit: provides \$500 monthly to a member's child who has lost both parents, up to age 19. This benefit also includes up to \$5,000 per year in college scholarships, with a maximum total of \$20,000, per eligible orphan.

Widow Benefit: offers surviving spouses of insured Knights the opportunity to purchase Knights of Columbus products, and she and her children are eligible for scholarships.

We strive to bring Father McGivney's mission to life by offering you these valuable benefits. I would like to sit down with you to walk you through the benefits available to your family. Thank you, and I pray that Blessed Michael McGivney watches over our families this month.

All eligibility provisions of the Order's program of fraternal benefits are not included. Terms and conditions apply.

Insurance members are those members who own a policy with a face value of \$15,000 or greater or with an annual premium of \$300 or greater. Other terms or restrictions may apply.

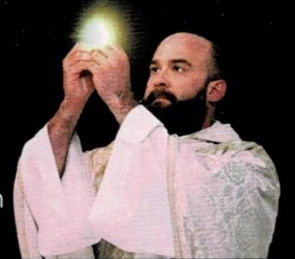

A Sacred Heart Holy Hour Program was conducted in the Adoration Chapel of Santa Maria del Mar Church. The prayer service was conducted during Eucharistic Adoration on the First Friday of September. The Sacred Heart travelling icon was on display during the service.

Grand Knight, Bryant Perszyk, offered the opening prayer. Faith Director Doug Hill and PGK Bob Conochalla assisted with the readings, Responsorial Psalm, Reflections, and Intercessions as outlined in the 'Sacred Heart Holy Hour' Booklet (#5050)

obtained from the Supreme Council. Brother Doug Hill recited the Chaplet of Divine Mercy with the attendees.

After the recitation of the 'Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus', GK Perszyk led the participants in the singing of the Tantum Ergo. The Blessed Sacrament was then reposed in the tabernacle.

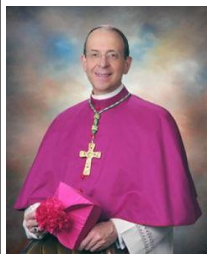

Supreme Chaplain's Challenge (October)

A monthly reflection and practical challenge from Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori



"But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.'" (Gospel for Oct. 26, Lk 18:13)

The parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector relates back to our August monthly challenge about humility. The Pharisee exalts himself before God, extolling his superiority and keeping of the law. Meanwhile, the tax collector prays with humility, seeking mercy for his sins. Our culture stresses the importance of "self-esteem," but we must also remember that all of us are sinners in need of God's mercy. We should never approach God in a

spirit of pride, but always humbly on our knees — confident of his loving mercy.

This month, the month dedicated to the holy rosary, I challenge you to pray five decades of the rosary daily, asking God for humility and mercy.

Questions for Reflection:

- Have there been times in your life when you pridefully compared yourself to others, like the Pharisee in this parable?
- Do you perform a regular and careful examination of conscience so as to remain humbly aware of your sinfulness?
- What other steps can you take to become more like the tax collector in this parable?

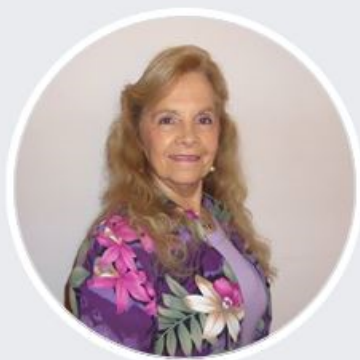
