We have a couple of really important dates on the liturgical calendar in the month of January. The first date is January 1st. On this date we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. We honor our Blessed Mother and her motherhood. We draw inspiration from the selfless love of Mary, who never hesitated to do the will of God. It is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics.

Next we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany on the first Sunday of January. In 2024 it will be Sunday, January 7th. On this feast, the Church celebrates the manifestation (epiphany) of Christ to the Nations (Gentiles) in the persons of the Magi—also known as the Wise Men or the Three Kings. The reference for this feast day is found in the Gospel of Matthew:

***When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the***

***Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage."***

***When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:***

***'And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel.'" Matt 2:1-6***

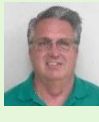

## Safe Haven Baby Box

Please help the Knights of Columbus install a Safe Haven Baby Box in the Palm Coast Fire Station on Belle Terre Drive.

The cost of installing the Baby Box is approximately \$16,000. The Knights of Columbus are raising funds to defer the cost. Your generous donation will help us place the Safe Haven Baby Box in Flagler County.

### What is a Safe Haven Baby Box?

A Baby Box is a safety device provided for under the state's Safe Haven Law and legally permits a mother in crisis to safely, securely, and anonymously surrender if they are unable to care for their newborn. A Baby Box is installed in an exterior wall of a designated fire station or hospital. It has an exterior door that automatically locks upon placement of a newborn inside the Baby Box, and an interior door which allows a medical staff member to secure the surrendered newborn from inside the designated building.

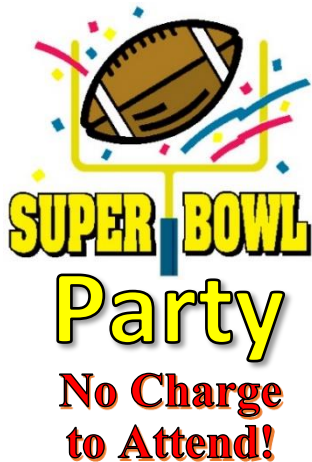


