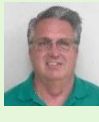

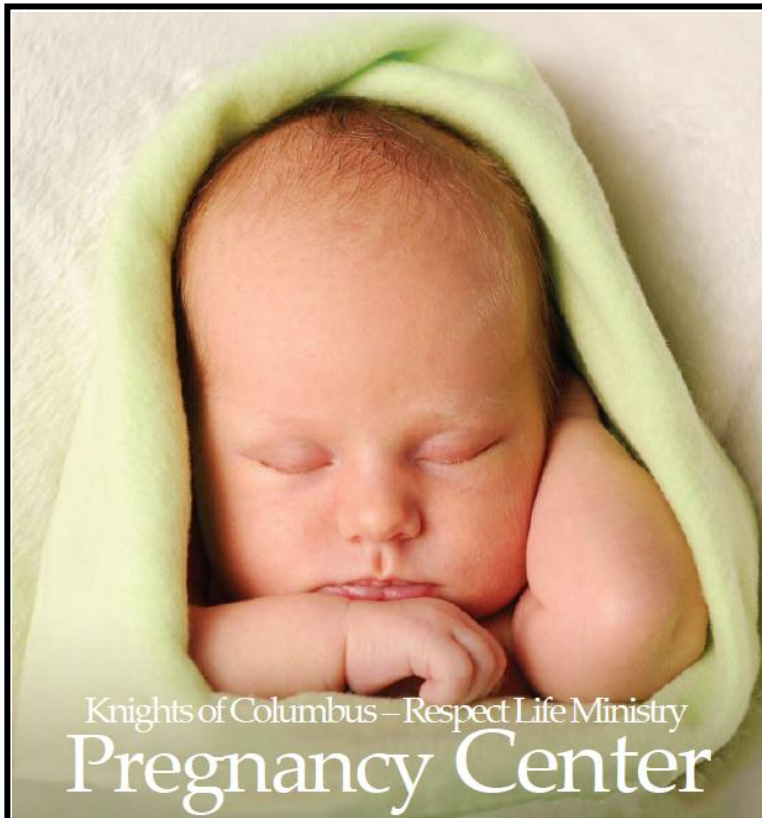

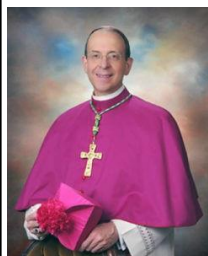

**"Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are." (Gospel for May 12, Jn 17:11b)**


