

My Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Grace and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you this new year! As we journeyed with our Blessed Mother Mary and her spouse, St. Joseph, through the Advent and Christmas seasons, we heard Scripture readings about the desire for a child and the wondrous work of God who gifts us each child. Manoah, of the tribe of Dan, and his wife were unable to have children, yet they prayed mightily for a child. The angel of the Lord appeared to Manoah's wife and spoke of her bearing a child who would be consecrated to God from the womb. She dedicated the child, Samson, to God that he might glorify God all his days. "The woman bore a son and named him Samson, and when the boy grew up the Lord blessed him". We heard about Hannah who also prayed for a child and when Samuel was born, she dedicated him to God in thanksgiving. Elizabeth, Mary's cousin, was childless and in her old age, bore a son, John. She also dedicated him to God. The angel, Gabriel, visits our Blessed Mother, announcing that she will bear a child, and name Him, Jesus, for He is the Savior of all people. A notary public is a public officer appointed by state government to serve the public in non-contentious matters, usually related to the signing of important documents. A notary public attests or certifies writings, such as deeds, to make them authentic and takes affidavits, depositions, and protests of negotiable paper. A notary public also administers oaths and affirmations, authenticates the execution of certain documents, and performs other official acts depending on the jurisdiction. A notary public acts as an impartial witness and a fraud -deterrent in transactions and documents. If you need documents notarized, we have at least 2 Notary Publics in our Council:

Susan B. Anthony was an anti-slavery abolitionist and a pioneer in the women's suffrage movement whose efforts culminated in the passage of the Thirteenth and Nineteenth Amendments respectively to the US Constitution. George Washington, known as the "Father of the Nation," led the Continental Army to victory in the Revolutionary War, presided over the drafting and ratification of the US Constitution, and served as the first President of the United States.

The annual Gerald Strohmeier Memorial Captain's Ball is coming up on February 24. Holy Mass will be celebrated in the Hall at 4pm by Fr.
