

My Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

We are in the Season of Christmas; yet, we also begin a new calendar year. During the Season of Advent, we made ready for the coming of Jesus, our Savior and Lord. We prayed to God to make within us a clean heart. We offered sacrifice upon God's altar and we received Him in the Eucharist.

As we receive Christ in the Eucharist, we continue salvation history for Jesus Christ is yesterday, today and forever.

I ask you this new year to not sway from your focus on God. Come to Mass. Receive the Eucharist – receive Jesus. Leave the holy altar of the sanctuary and Be the Eucharist – BE- going out into the world glorifying the Lord with your life. Let everyone know Jesus through your marvelous works of charity; by the words you speak and the way you treat all the people.

Grow your works of charity that our unified heart throbs and overflows. Let every moment be a prayer of the Father – transfiguration the darkness into light that we are redient at what we see
