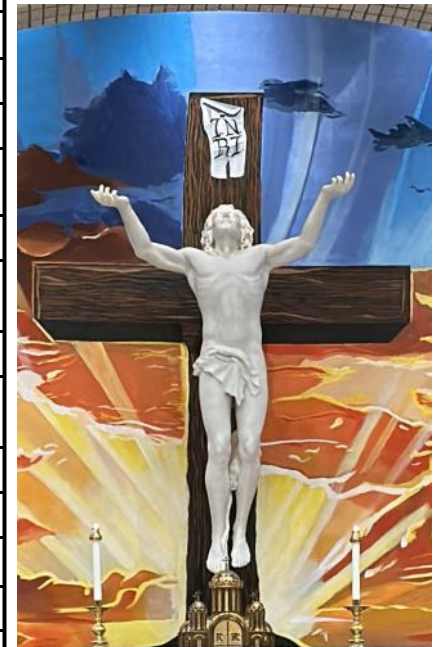

Brothers, when Father McGivney founded our Order, a key part of his mission was to help Catholic families attain a secure financial future. In keeping with that mission, Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly recently announced updates to our member benefits. Whether or not you are an insured Knight of Columbus, you are entitled to the Member/Spouse Fraternal Benefit. This is an accidental death benefit which varies from \$1,500-\$5,000, depending on your age, whether you are insured and how long you've been a member. The other updates I'd like to call out apply to insured members. Family Fraternal Benefit: It's guaranteed-issue insurance up to \$10,000 to any child under age 18, regardless of physical or intellectual disabilities. This also includes an automatic \$5,000 death benefit for children who die before age 61 days, including stillbirths from at least 20 weeks after conception. Orphan Fraternal Benefit: provides \$500 monthly to a member's child who has lost both parents, up to age 19. This benefit also includes up to \$5,000 per year in college

scholarships, with a maximum total of \$20,000, per eligible orphan. Widow Benefit: offers surviving spouses of insured Knights the opportunity to purchase Knights of Columbus products, and she and her children are eligible for scholarships. We strive to bring Father McGivney's mission to life by offering you these valuable benefits. I would like to sit down with you to walk you through the benefits available to your family. Thank you, and I pray that Blessed Michael McGivney watches over our families this month. Vivat Jesus! God bless & Stay safe.

# Deacon's Teaching

## Sacred Images – Iconography

Iconoclasm, Greek for "image-breaking", is the destruction of religious symbols. (Deuteronomy 4:15-18, Exodus 20:4 "graven images", Exodus 20:2-4, Judges 6:25-26, 2 Corinthians 10:5 ) In these citations, however, God is only forbidding images for worship, e.g., the 'golden calf' (Ex. 32:7-8). He has not, however, banned all religious images.

For instance, the Lord instructed the Israelites to store the Ten Commandments in an ark made of acacia wood decorated with golden images of cherubim. He also commanded the decoration of the Temple with gold, bronze, and wooden images of animals and plants. (Exodus 25, 26, 27; 1 Kings 6,7; 2 Chronicles

3, 4) Moses' rod had the image of a snake on top with which he performed miracles, but it was not worshiped! (Numbers 21:6-9, John 3:14)

Old Testament images of God were forbidden because God had not yet been seen. But in the New Testament, God took on a human form and was seen:

Colossians 1:15 "*He (Jesus) is the*

*image of the invisible God...*"

Colossians 2:9 "*For in Jesus dwells the whole fullness of the Deity...*"

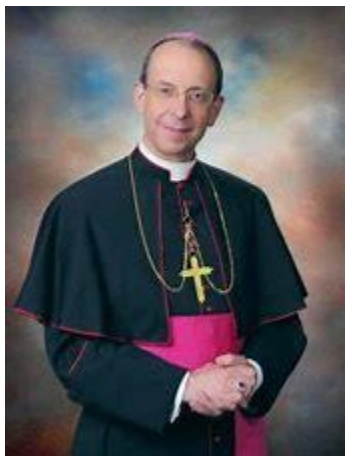
John 1:1, "*In the beginning, was the Word (Logos), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God (Jesus).*"

1 John 1:1-2 "*What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we looked upon and touched with our hands concerns the Word of life – for the life was made visible...*". Jesus, therefore, is an icon of our invisible God!

The Catholic Church does not worship its icons; they are to express love and honor for the image they represent.

In October, autumn comes into full swing. Let's get in the fall mood!

Columbus Day, a federal holiday, is observed on the second Monday in October. It was on October 12, 1492, that Christopher Columbus landed on a small island in the Bahamas, convinced that he had reached Asia. October 24 is United Nations Day, which aims to bring awareness to the work of the United Nations worldwide. October 31 is Halloween (All Hallows' Eve)

Hurricane Helene formed as a tropical storm in the Gulf of Mexico in September 2024. The eighth named storm and fifth hurricane of the 2024 Atlantic hurricane season, it developed from a broad area of low pressure in the Western Caribbean Sea on September 24.

Helene made landfall as a Category 4 hurricane about 11:10 p.m. ET near Perry, Florida, with 140 mph winds, the National Hurricane Center reported. The storm, which now marks the first known Category 4 storm to hit Florida's Big Bend region since records began in 1851, weakened to a tropical storm Friday morning as it barreled through Georgia, causing life-threatening flooding in Atlanta and the Carolinas.

breathing hope into the places that feel broken.

We remember the victims of Hurricane Helene. Charity, a noble quality in man, brings welfare in the society.
