From the Deacon's Bench

The Road from Emmaus to Pentecost



Pentecost

Greetings as we begin the month of June, with much joy and gladness.

OK —

with the start of the 2025 hurricane season maybe not so much. But, think about it this way:

We have a new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. (Pray for him often as he begins his service to the Church!)

We have 4 newly ordained Priests, for our Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee. One from Saint Rose, Father William Gibson, who celebrated his First Mass, 1 June.

And we are preparing to celebrate

Pentecost.

"Veni, Sancte Spiritus! - Come, Holy Spirit

Pope Benedict reminds us that:

Pentecost invites us to return to the origins of the Church, which, as we affirm in the Second Vatican Council, was "made manifest in the outpouring of the Spirit"

(Lumen Gentium, no. 2).

On the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended with power upon the Apostles; thus began the mission of the Church, the Birthday of the Church, if you will, and the close of the Easter Season.

Jesus himself prepared the Eleven for this mission, appearing to them on many occasions after his Resurrection (see Acts 1: 3).

Prior to the Ascension into Heaven, he ordered them "not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father" (see Acts 1: 4-5); that is, he asked them to stay together to prepare themselves to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. And they gathered in prayer with Mary in the Upper Room, awaiting the promised event (see Acts 1: 14).

To stay together

was the condition laid down by Jesus in order to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit; the premise of their harmony was prolonged prayer. In this way we are offered a formidable lesson for every Christian community: **Unity! Prayer!** And ultimately **Service!**

The story of Pentecost takes us to the Upper Room; How many are there we do not know, but what we do know is that images used by St Luke to indicate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit - **wind** and **fire** - recall Sinai, where God revealed himself to the people of Israel and offered his covenant (see Ex 19: 3ff.). The feast of Sinai, which Israel celebrated 50 days after the Passover, was the feast of the Covenant.

Speaking of the tongues of fire (see Acts 2: 3), St Luke records Pentecost as a new Sinai, as the feast of the New Covenant, where the Covenant with Israel is extended to **all** the nations of the earth. And this is the mystery of Pentecost: the Holy Spirit illuminates the human spirit and, by revealing Christ Crucified and Risen, indicates the way to become more like him, that is, to be

"the image and instrument of the love which flows from Christ"

(Deus Caritas Est, no. 33).

The Church, gathered, shouts with Joy: Veni, Sancte Spiritus! - Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love!

I pray with this Feast of Pentecost, fast approaching, you take the time to reflect on the many great, powerful, wonderful gifts the Holy Spirit has given you and how to better use them in Unity, Prayer and service.



Kolbe Prison Ministries

"Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them...." (Hebrews 13: 3)

Sacrificial responses come in many forms. Money to buy the books on the Catholic Faith, hours spent in the kitchen cooking delicious meals for the inmates and prayers for return of the lost sheep. Without the sacrifice of the clergy and those volunteers who enter the prison to serve, no retreat would happen. From the first Kolbe retreat in 2023 to three in 2024, we plan to have at least six Kolbe Retreats during 2025 in the PT Diocese. We have already

had Century #4 in February, with 3 Kolbe Retreats planned for this summer:

Santa Rosa #2 Retreat	June 12-14
Holmes Mission Retreat	July 17-19
Century #5 Retreat	August 13-15.

To pull this off, we need about 20 male volunteers to enter the prison for each retreat. We do not expect volunteers to make all three retreats. So, here is the plan: recruit and mentor more volunteers. If you are interested contact



Supreme Chaplain's Challenge

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always." (Gospel for June 8, Jn 14:15-16)

Last month, we reflected on how Jesus probed Peter three times with the question "Do you love me?" Here we have an answer to what it means to truly love Jesus — by keeping his commandments, as expressed in Scripture and in the teachings of the Church. The monthly challenge for March underscored how our faith bears fruit in what we do. Let us remember that to keep the commandments for love of Christ is to allow the Holy Spirit to bear good fruits in our lives.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to use the Catholic Information Service® resource *A Guide to Confession*, which is organized around the Ten Commandments, to examine your conscience and then go to confession.

Questions for Reflection:

What is your response to Jesus' question, "Do you love me?" Do you show your love for Christ in how you live? In what ways do you need to become more attentive to the commandments and the teachings of the Church?
