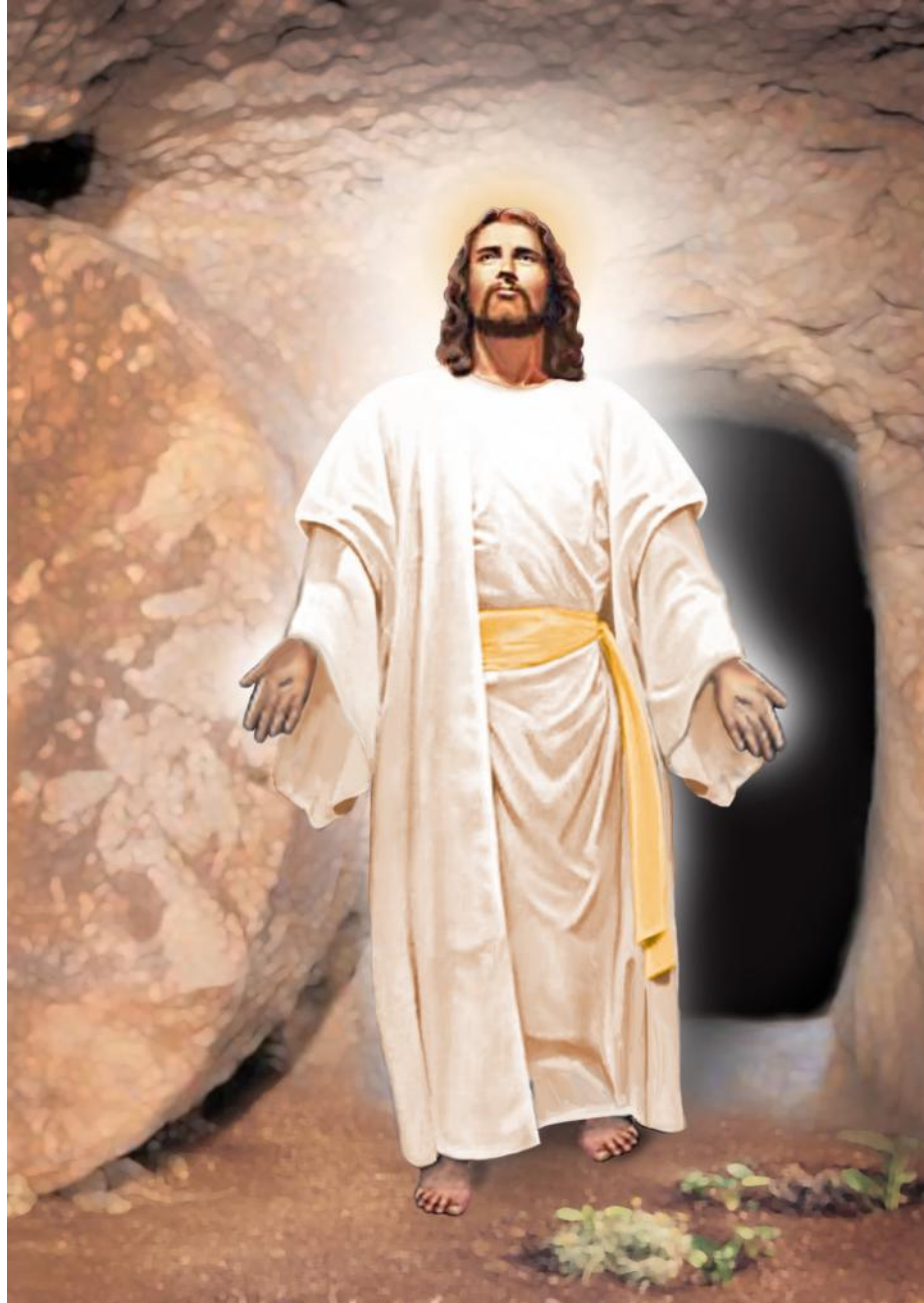

# The Gathering



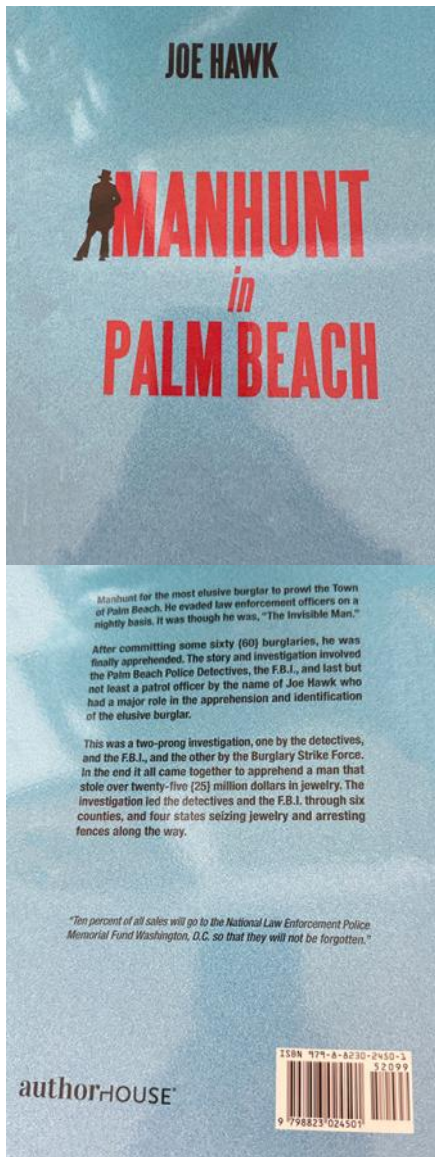
Our last gathering was a successful one. A lot Brothers and their wives enjoyed the evening and the food was great.
