Once again, too few Knights participated in the collection. And again, SK Mario Acevedo has run this event in the past but was not able to do it this year. 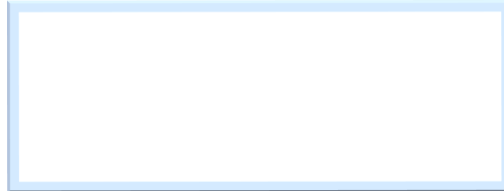
