Corps Report for March 2024

The funeral for Brother Thomas Orban, a member of Council 12569, was held on Tuesday, Jan. 30, at Church of the Epiphany. Jerry Wojciechowski, Jose Vigara, Chris Hennessy and myself were among seven SKs from three assemblies. SK Jerry Wojciechowski represented our Assembly at Prince of Peace on Saturday, Feb. 3, as part of an eight-man team for the funeral for SK Joseph Dougherty.

I served as CCC for Confirmation with Bishop Erik Pohlmeier on Sunday, Feb., 11, at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Palm Coast. We had nine SKs in regalia for an impressive ceremony for 38 Confirmandi.

The funeral for Barbara Cohen Pippin was held on Feb. 13 at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Palm Coast, where I was one of nine SKs in regalia. She was the wife of SK Welman Pippin, a frequent supporter of call-outs at OLOH and Volusia County. Assembly 2794 took the lead for the funeral for Brother Charles "Chip" Crouch on Saturday, Feb. 17, at Church of the Epiphany. I was joined by SK Jerry Wojciechowski from our assembly, along with Welman Pippin, Mike Worley and Bob Simcoe.

I was privileged to serve on a 36-man Color Corps led by Florida Master John O'Toole for the combined funerals of Father Bob Hoeffner and his sister in Viera on Feb. 20. The Hoeffners were murdered on Jan. 28. Bishop John Noonan was joined by around 60 other concelebrant priests at the Mass at St. John the Evangelist.

We had two events on Friday, Feb. 23. First, the funeral for SK Joseph Hockdoerfer was held at Our Lady of Hope. We had eight SKs from two assemblies, including Jose Vigara, Wes Wengren, Jerry Wojciechowski, Chris Hennessy, Jacques Roch, Ted Morrell and myself from 2794. Six SKs then rotated for 15-minute shifts during exposition of the relic of the right arm of St. Jude at the Basilica of St. Paul, followed by Mass in honor of St. Jude. SK Tim Carnego joined myself and Orlando Diocese Vice Marshall Bruce Winner at the very moving ceremony.

Finally, the wedding for SK Wayne Gartman was held at the St. Stephen Catholic Chapel in Bunnell on Saturday, Feb. 24. I was part of a 13-man Color Corps that provided an arch of swords for the couple.
