Former 4955 District Deputy Gary McLain offers clues to past success

During the 2024 Florida State Convention in May, I spoke with Gary McClain, PSD, FM. Gary attended St. Anastasia High School, just north of where I'm now stationed. He converted to Catholicism shortly after enlisting in our military. He married his beloved Joan 62 years ago in 1962. We also spoke at-length on his term as 4955's District Deputy from 1981-1985.

Council 4955 garnered its greatest concentration of awards during these four years. Two of those years, 4955 won "Florida State Council of the Year," but for the 1984-1985 fraternal year, 4955 "swept" nearly every possible award offered by both Supreme and State at the time, a feat that's unprecedented, and yet to be matched or exceeded.

Gary first acknowledged, "the leadership never had to be told what to do." Although he collaborated with them at almost every event, he said they had the initiative, originality and creativity to not only seek out opportunities to serve, but also how to most effectively exceed all aspirations. Gary also stressed that proper decorum was non-negotiable at council meetings.

Gary also confirmed my theory on another factor of 4955's success. Our Home Corporation had the unique position of not only owning the council clubrooms (which was/is the norm for all councils with nonliquid assets), but also the shopping center in which the clubrooms were situated. Sure enough, the steady flow of lease income, from the various storefronts offset expenses, which freed-up the membership to focus not on how to "pay the bills," but on how to do the greatest amount of good for the community. This gave 4955 a unique advantage over any other council clubhouse. (Note: with а The shopping center closed around 1988

to accommodate hall expansions that never materialized.)

Gary was consoled to hear that although we no longer have the hall (which he earlier called "a showplace for the Order"), 4955 currently has access to the facilities at St. Gabriel, with the major benefits of owning a hall without any of the major drawbacks, such as "paying the bills" required to maintain a building.

Gary and Joan have been my close friends and deep supporters



before, during and after seminary formation. He remains active in many ways, including as Florida State Father McGivney Guild Chairman.

With great joy, he exclaimed "4955 *IS* still one of the best councils!" Gary believes the current generation of members can restore, and perhaps even exceed, 4955's former glory.
