Council Special Projects Director Guy DeJohn worked with parish and archdiocesan staff to organize the work. Deputy Grand Knight David Rouchard is the Knights' parish representative.



Council members presented \$1,000 May 12 to Palm Beach Diocese Catholic Charities in support of the Women's Pregnancy Solutions and Director Chelsea Simmons. Members toured the agency's mobile exam vehicle. Volunteers take the van to remote locations in the diocese to counsel and support clients with their pregnancies.



Council members Dan Woronkiewicz and John Yardley presented Archdiocese of Miami Respect Life Ministry Director Angela Curatalo with a Certificate of Appreciation May 13 with a donation of \$3,000 from Knights. The Pregnancy Help Center on Commercial Boulevard attracts 8-12 clients a day – more since Florida's six-week abortion law took effect -- providing ultrasound exams, counseling, training and infant supplies. Mobile exam vehicles and more volunteers also are needed.
