

Candidates interested in running for council offices at the May 11 meeting should contact members of the Nominating Committee, including Chris Long, David Rouchard and Mike Charles, by March 31. Only Third Degree members qualify. The following positions will be on the ballot:

Grand Knight – Presides over council meetings, ex-officio member of all committees, appoints membership and program directors, lecturer, committees, convenes officers for monthly meeting, ensures reports are submitted to state and Supreme Council; aware of council's financial status and signs all checks.

Deputy Grand Knight – Assists grand knight with council affairs; presides at council meetings in absence of grand knight; chairman of retention committee.

Chancellor – Assists grand knight and deputy grand knight, oversees council in their absence; charged with strengthening members' interests in council activities, chairman of admission committee.

Recorder – Maintains record of all council actions and correspondence.

Treasurer – Maintains records of all council funds and accounts; deposits money into council's accounts and provides certificate of such monies to the grand knight; also pays expenses.

Advocate – Legal representative of council, serves as council's attorney at trials and investigations; does not need to be legal professional, but should be familiar with council bylaws, the Order's Charter, Constitution and Laws, Methods of Conducting a Council Meeting and Robert's Rules of Order.

Warden – Watchdog for council property and degree paraphernalia, responsible for setting up council chambers for meetings and ceremonials.

Inside and Outside Guards – Outside guard admits visitors and members to inner door. The inside guard checks to make sure that membership cards are current.

Trustee – Three members elected by council, plus grand knight, who serves as chairman of board; oversee work of financial secretary and treasurer, and with deputy grand knight serve on retention committee.

Our Lady has made 15 promises regarding the recitation of the Rosary, which show just how powerful the Rosary is in the face of the monsters we profiled:

1. Those who faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive signal graces.

2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.

3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell. It will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.

4. The recitation of the Rosary will cause virtue and good works to flourish. It will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God. It will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.

5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.

6. Those who recite my Rosary devoutly, applying themselves to the consideration of its sacred mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune.
