The council's charitable endowment was created in 2014 with the remaining proceeds from the dissolved Pompano KofC Home Corporation sale of the council hall in 2000.

The resolution and policy were approved August 4 by the Board of Trustees and officers and recommended to membership following a lengthy review of options.
