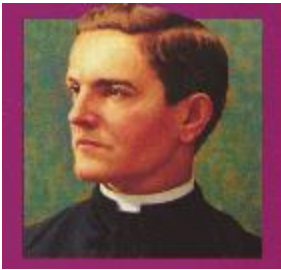
# Prayers
