• Don Schluender spoke again about Amendment 4 that will appear on the November ballot. The amendment, labeled "Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion" is extreme. It eliminates virtually all safeguards, including for the health of the mother. It eliminates parental consent for minors, and with exceptions, permits abortion up to birth. Everything is also completely free and getting this done will allow you to do volunteer work around school kids.

Treasurer's Report




The treasurer reported for July through June 30st, that is the full year, Council income of \$373,031 which includes 207,075 returned from the Orlando Diocese, previously offered in anticipation of gaining the Sheedy Center for meetings. Operating Income was 165,956.

Expenses were \$ 110,363, mostly donations, Bingo payouts and Fish Fry expenses. Lastly the audit report has been prepared for the trustees to review and approve.
