

Don Schluender spoke again about Amendment 4 that will appear on the November ballot. The amendment, labeled "Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion" is extreme. It eliminates virtually all safeguards, including for the health of the mother. It eliminates parental consent for minors, and with exceptions, permits abortion up to birth. Treasurer's Report




The treasurer reported July through May 31st, income of \$ 155,816 and expenditures of \$ 105,196, mostly donations, Bingo payouts and Fish Fry expenses. Separately the Diocese returned about \$207k that the Council had contributed in anticipation of occupying half of the Sheedy Center. A thank you note was received from Fr. Joseph for past support of seminarians and a recommendation to continue such support. Then a proposal was made to contribute \$250 to each of the two new priests who were ordained two weeks ago. Such donation is within the budget.
