• Let us know if you are interested in being an officer for the next council year. We are looking for a few good men to step up.




Treasurer's Report

The treasurer reported July through February 29th, income of \$94,238 and expenditures of \$57,944. The check the Council had paid to the Diocese/Resurrection for use of a part of the Sheedy Center has been returned, with interest, as was previously committed. It was suggested and approved it would be put into CD, but at different bank(s) to avoid the insurance limitation.
