This year we will continue to offer online payment of dues through the website, but going forward we will not add a surcharge for online payments. Online payments will be the same amount due as if you paid with a check or cash. The dues are \$25 for regular members, \$11.80 for honorary members and free for honorary lifetime members. One becomes an honorary member when they reach the age of 65 and have been a member of the Knights of Columbus for 25 consecutive

- years. An honorary life membership requires the member to be 70 years old and have 25 consecutive years of membership or have been a member for 50 years regardless of age.

# Treasurer's Report




The treasurer reported for July through April Income was \$160,966 and expenses were \$103,877, the largest of which was charity
