

Our Chaplain is on vacation. This is a reprint of his July 2016 article


Brother Knights,

According to the liturgical year of the Church, we are now in the ëOrdinary time until the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Solemnity of Christ the King marks the last Sunday in the liturgical year of the Church, before the first Sunday of Advent, which marks the beginning of the liturgical year of the Church. In our ordinary activities during the year, this time (June-July-August) is a vacation time for many of us. It is good to remember that strictly there is no vacation for spiritual matters. If we al-low ourselves vacation for spiritual matters (i.e. relaxing or resting from spiritual matters) then we will be inviting spiritual problems in our lives. Brother Knights, let us remember the incident of our Lord Jesus who sent his disciples for a mission (Mk. 6:7-13). After a successful mission, they returned to Jesus and gave a report of their work to him. I believe Jesus was happy with their report. He saw that they needed a short vacation after their hard work. He invited them, iCome away by your-selves to a deserted place and rest a while (Mk. 6:31a). Brothers, after our busiest months, we need a short vacation (not necessarily going away from home). During this time of vacation for many of us, it is good to invite Jesus to accompany us all the time and through his Spirit he will restore to us again the energy we spent in serving him, his church and our brothers and sisters in our communities. After vacation with him we can even serve better than before.




