He began as an infantryman, later joining the Army Air Corps as a waist-gunner on a B-24 Liberator. In those early days, he was on a troop transport truck when they were strafed by a Japanese fighter. Brothers in arms were jumping from the truck to escape; whether it was fear or divine providence, he couldn't move; he began praying to the Blessed Mother for Her Help.

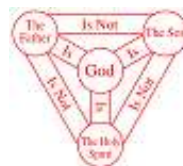
