

When you're the smallest, you try harder; our +Parents chose to open holidays; to subsidize sales of course, but most importantly to serve our customers.

There was always that loaf of bread, gallon of milk or pumpkin pie that was needed. My siblings & I would take turns working the holiday openings, alternating every other one, giving +Mom & +Dad the "day off". The phone would ring constantly, "Are you open today?"... 


