Over the past month, we've completed required areas including the Keep Christ in Christmas magnets; Keep Christ in Christmas poster contest; youth soccer and the free throw contest. We're happy to see our work continuing, and that newer members have stepped up in many of the programs.

We will be distributing Keep Christ in Christmas magnets following each Mass in the near future. Other activities such as the Novena for Life and Tootsie Rolls will begin in the near future; we also look forward to getting back to our monthly pancake breakfasts, Habitat for Humanity, Duck Derby sales and other activities.
