Dear Brother Knights,

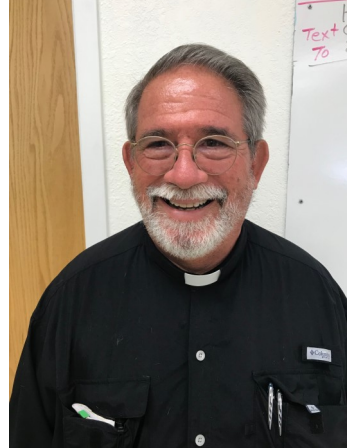
Congratulations on our Lady of Hope council 8086 being selected as Council of the Year for the State Knights of Columbus.
