November got off to a great start with the Fourth Annual Duck Derby.

The location was different—L.A. Fitness instead of the small City Center lake. But, as the Marines say, you Adapt ... Improvise ... and Overcome!

Unfortunately, the fund raising opportunities that we've taken advantage of in the past, with the community events at City Center, New Smyrna Beach and other locations canceled, we've had to change our plans and do what we could.

Despite the lack of public events, Tim Mell and his crew managed to sell 1,281 ducks, which were turned loose in the L.A. Fitness pool at 1 p.m. on Sunday, Nov. 1. SK Richie Smatt "rescued" the winning ducks, with \$1,800 going to the lucky winners.

Early indications are that we are close to our non-pandemic projections—good news for our community projects.

Our first public duck sale was at the blessing of the pets on Oct. 4. For a first-time event, that worked out very nicely, with about 40 pets blessed by Father Matt and Father Kachinda. All dogs and cats, no alligators!

Our first Corporate Communion on Oct. 11 was also a success with a good turnout of Knights.

We also had another successful March for Life. I counted 27 Knights, with a total of more than 50 people who each gave one hour on Sunday, Oct. 25. It was very rewarding to hear the overwhelming response from the passers by, many honking their horns, waving or giving thumbs up. I didn't hear of a single negative comment.

Any Third Degree Knights (including those who recently completed the new Degree of Charity, Unity and Fraternity) who wish to attain the honors of the Fourth Degree will have the opportunity on Saturday, Nov. 28. Originally planned for Bradenton, the Exemplification will now be held at St. Stephen Catholic Church in Riverview (East of Tampa, near the junction of Interstates 4 and 75).

The Coats for Kids have been received, and will be distributed to the participating schools this month. There will be a vote to approve an additional \$3,000 for the Coats for Kids fund.

Also, the annual Mass of Remembrance will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 24, at Prince of Peace at 7 p.m. The Mass will honor all Knights who passed away since the beginning of the 2020 Columbian Year.
