In that same spirit, we take this opportunity to recognize the accomplishments of our Order as we heard some of the statistics that were shared at the Supreme Convention in August, 2022. \$154 million in donations to worthy causes by our members in the last fraternal year. 48 million hours of volunteer service by our members. \$19 million donated to the Ukraine Solidarity Fund (at end of Summer, 2022). \$10.1 million to food drives. \$3.7 million to Special Olympics. We should all be very proud of the Order that we are a part of. Let's do our part to help in the effort!

We're fortunate that the Worthy Deputy Grand Knight has put forth a number of the activities that both the Knights and OLQA will be putting on in October. Put these on your calendar and please make an effort to attend, if you are able. However, let me add one more. As some of you may already know, the Knights of Columbus (through the efforts of our Supreme Knight) have produced a documentary film on the life of Saint Teresa of Calcutta. It is set to show at our Regal Theater in Royal Palm Beach on Monday, October 3rd and Tuesday, October 4th. Both days at 7:00pm. I'll advocate for October 4th simply so that you're able to also attend the Living Rosary. But perhaps let's try to sell out the theater and in the process make this an event that we can enjoy a little fellowship at. Looking forward to seeing many of you this coming month.

There are numerous activities and events occurring this October on both a council and Church level.

On a council level we start the month off with "The Living Rosary" at the pavilion at 6:00 PM Monday evening October 3, 2022. We had a very good showing of knights and parishioners last year at the event, and I hope we can repeat last years showing. This is a knights event, so come dressed in your knights shirts if you have them.

On October 20, 2022 we will be having our "Spaghetti Dinner" at Celebration Hall. The dinner will begin at 5:00PM and will not only be a very nice family event, it will be economical as well. We expect to be charging \$12.00 per adult for the full dinner including beer, wine and desert. St. Ignatius charges \$20.00 for the same dinner, and I doubt it will be as good as ours.

On October 30, 2022 we will be having our K of C Sunday "Pancake Breakfast" after the 8:00AM and 9:45 AM masses at the pavilion. The costs will be \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for children for pancakes, sausage, eggs, juice, milk and coffee. Please make it a point to attend and support these events by attending with your family and friends. All the profits, as you know, go to the Church and other charities supported by our council. The Church is also sponsoring a number of events members may be interested in. On October 1st and 2nd The Divine Mercy Conference which began on September 29, 2022 will continue on October 1st and 2nd in Celebration Hall.

On the first Sunday of every month, (this month Oct. 2nd) Deacon Rodney conducts a spiritual meditation hour. It begins at 2:00PM inside the Church with a Eucharistic Adoration, and the Gregorian Chant in the background. It usually finishes up with a Rosary and a Litany of the Saints. A very nice way to spend a very special hour with the Lord.

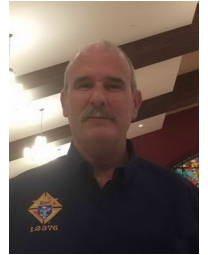

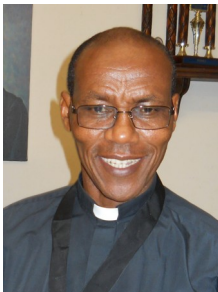

Chaplain's Monthly Message

Reprint from October 2018

Brother Knights,



According to the Church practice, the month of October is dedicated to our Mother Mary as "Our Lady Queen of the Holy Rosary" or simply the month of the Holy Rosary. We usually celebrate "Our Lady of the Holy Rosary" on October 7th. This year, since October 7th falls on Sunday, the Sunday Liturgy will take preference.

The Rosary is a simple prayer. It can be prayed individually or in a group or in a community, anywhere and in any place. Praying the Rosary with devotion, meditating on the mysteries of Christ in our salvation, enriches us in our spiritual growth and experience the power of this prayer. The Church in dedicating the month of October as the month of the Holy Rosary does not mean that we pray the Rosary this month only, but shows the importance of this prayer and therefore the need to pray it always because it is a powerful prayer in which Mary, Mother of Jesus, Mother of God and our mother is involved.

Many saints have prayed the Rosary and helped others to pray it. Our Lady herself in the apparitions to the children of Fatima - Lucia, Francis and Jacintha reminded the need to rosary for peace and conversion in the world. Many recent popes spoke about the spiritual benefits of praying the rosary. Pope Leo 13th spoke of the rosary as a powerful medicine for evils in the world.

Brother Knights, we are now experiencing in the Church, a painful atmosphere due to the recent news of clerical sexual abuse of minors and those who protected the abusers. The victims have suffered in many ways for a long time. With the victims, we feel betrayed by those we trusted.

Instead of serving them and protecting them, they spoiled and destroyed them. We want the victims to know that the Church is now with them and through her leaders, is asking forgiveness for what happened to them and the Church leaders' failure to act immediately and properly in dealing with both the victims and the abusers.

Brothers, since the Church is the mystical body of Christ with many members, the actions of the abusers, the suffering of the victims and the covering up of some church leaders, all these affected the Church as a whole in a very negative way. We are invited to pray and even fasting for healing of the victims, the abusers, those church leaders who failed to act properly and immediately and the Church as a whole. With open minds and hearts to the Holy Spirit, let us cooperate with Church leaders to prevent such actions from ever happening again now and in the future. Since Mary, the mother of the church has intervened in different ways in the Church in critical times, we are invited to pray the Holy Rosary this month and always so that God may grant healing we need most in this time and His kingdom to continue to grow all over the world through the ministry of the
