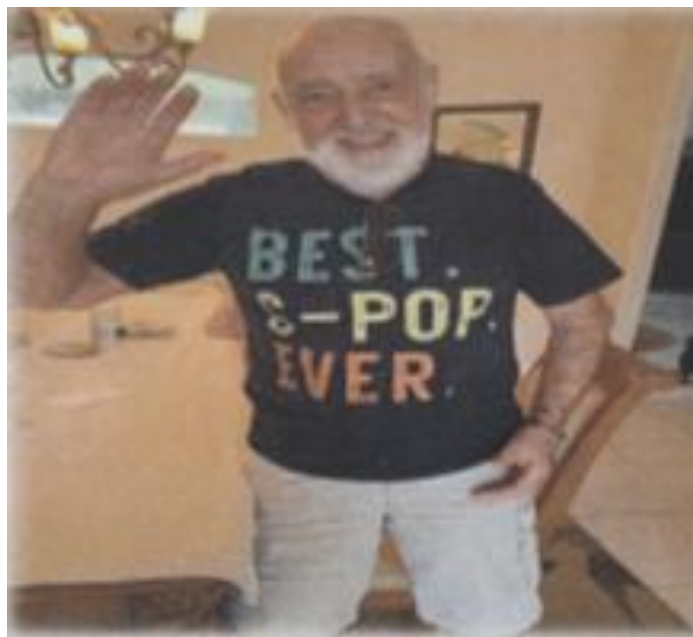
### Obituary for Al O'Donnell

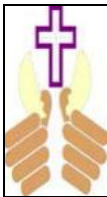
