



Despite polarizing political battles in several states since the overturning of *Roe v. Wade*, the annual Knights of Columbus-Marist Poll continues to show areas of common ground between pro-life and pro-choice Americans. Most notably, two-thirds (66%) of Americans — including 48% of those who describe themselves as pro-choice — support placing legal limits on abortion, and nearly 6 in 10 support limiting abortions to the first three months of pregnancy.

"Once again, most Americans are steadfast in their belief that abortion should be significantly limited, yet laws should include exceptions for rape, incest or to save the life of the mother," says Dr. Barbara L. Carvalho, director of the Marist Poll. "This clear trend found in the annual Knights of Columbus-Marist Poll has continued, nearly two years after the Supreme Court's landmark Dobbs decision."

A majority of Americans (58%) oppose abortion when a child will be born with Down syndrome, and a large majority (86%) oppose abortion on the basis of sex or gender. The survey also found that two-thirds of Americans believe health care professionals with religious objections to abortions should not be legally required to perform them, while 86% of respondents believe that laws can protect both the mother and her unborn child.

One of the most significant areas of agreement highlighted by the survey is support for pregnancy resource centers: 83% of Americans support or strongly support centers that offer help to mothers both during their pregnancy and after their baby is born.
