All the skills needed you already acquired by the third grade, such as cutting and pasting, finger painting etc. A few modern day skills are also utilized such as printing files from a Word Doc.

The Gold cross and the pink dove along with the calligraphy are all printed decals, you simply cut them out, paste them in the shell and when dry you slather the shell with a UV activated resin using your best pre-K finger painting skills. Set it outside in the sun for a bit and its done.

2024 Florida ballot proposal: Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

LAW CHANGES:

- NO MORE time limits on abortions.
