Saint of the Month:

JOHN THE BAPTIST

John the Baptist was Jesus' older cousin. He was a prophet sent by God to prepare people for the coming of Christ into the world.

John's parents were Elizabeth and Zechariah. They were an elderly couple who had nearly given up hope that their marriage would be blessed with a child. Then the angel Gabriel appeared to Zechariah in the temple and told him that Elizabeth would give birth to a son. Gabriel said they should name the child John. (Read about the birth of John in Luke 1:57-80.)

The Gospel of Luke also tells us about the mission God gave to John. He was called to tell people to repent, or to be sorry for, their sins and to be baptized. Before Christ began his public ministry, John told the people to "Prepare the way of the Lord" (Luke 3:4). He said, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs on his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire" (Luke 3:16).

John baptized Jesus in the Jordan River. Luke tells us that the heavens opened at that moment and the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus. Then the voice of God spoke, saying, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (Luke 3:21-22).

John preached against King Herod, who was married to his brother's wife. This was a great sin because the brother was still living. The wife's name was Herodias. She demanded that Herod arrest John.

Herodias plotted with her daughter, Salome, for revenge against John. At a party, Salome danced for Herod. Her dancing tempted Herod, and he promised Salome that that he would give her anything she wanted. She asked for John the Baptist's head on a platter. John was martyred that night.

Just as John prepared people for the coming of Jesus, his brutal death prepared Jesus' followers for Christ's sacrifice on the cross. We thank God for St. John the Baptist. We can honor him by preparing the way for Jesus by being sorry for our sins and trying to live as loving children of God.

May in Review

May felt like one of those 'Business as Usual' months. We did a lot, but somehow it was mostly projects/service activities we are used to performing. We also had a BUNCH of activities on one special weekend – May 13-15.

May 13 – the **Knights of Columbus Florida State Convention** kicked off at the Grand Hyatt on International Drive. Councils from around the State gathered and opened the Convention with a parade of Council Banners. Council 5958's banner was proudly carried by Delegate Alan Schlagter!

May 14 – under the leadership of brother Jim Valentine, 5 Knights (Brian Fitzgerald, Tom Wilhelm, Bob Valentine and Ray Standard) arrived at 0-dark-thirty (that's a military term for real early) Saturday morning at the Pine Castle Civic Center to begin directing arriving cars to the correct parking lot(s) for the **Servant's Heart Ministry "Hearts against Hunger" 5 k run/walk**. This is a major fundraiser for the Food Bank/Distribution Charity (see their Profile in the Grand Knight's Message in the April Vessel). A large number of runners/walkers turned out, and we understand that the event was very successful in raising money for the cause. Our Knights' job was done by 9:00 am, and they were able to depart and go home for a well deserved nap.



At the State Convention, Delegates Alan Schlagter and Mark Bassett voted during the Business meeting to increase the State per Capita by \$2/Knight. The Knights have lost significant membership due to Covid lockdowns and State efforts to help reduce the overhead of inactive members. It was a simple choice: either raise the per Capita, or lose significant benefits, not the least of which would have been the Liability Insurance that protects all our Councils.



May 15 – A jam packed day!

Coffee & Donuts: The Knights hosted the monthly Coffee and Donuts event after the 7:00, 9:00 and 11:00 AM Masses. Since we ran out of donuts last month, we ordered 20 dozen donuts and ended up having some left over. The extras were taken to the Russell Home for Atypical Children, who received the gift with gratitude and delight. Thanks to PGK Eric Rodriguez, DGK Tom Wilhelm, Bob Valentine, Jim Valentine, Ray Standard and Sean Reedy for all their work to make it happen!



Corporate Communion: The Knights and their families gathered at the 9:00 AM Mass for the quarterly Corporate Communion. We began with recitation of the Rosary before Mass, and as usual, all sat in a reserved set of pews. Father Carlos did a wonderful job of recognizing Council 5958 and the services we perform for the Parish. After Mass we adjourned to the Social Hall for some...Coffee & Donuts!! The event was not as well attended as past Corporate Communions, but that may be due to some last minute date changes. We'll do better next time!

Altar Server(s) of the Year: At the close of the 9:00 AM Mass, Youth Director Jim Valentine presented the Altar Server of the year Award to a brother – sister team that serves at that Mass regularly. Katelyn and Ryan Pyka are outstanding examples of Catholic Youth. Jim made sure to highlight the reasons they were selected as our Altar Servers of the Year for 2021-2022. Thanks to Altar Server Coordinator Jen Williamson for nominating the Pykas and providing a list of their accomplishments as athletes, scholars and leaders.

State Convention: Back at the State Convention, Delegate Alan Schlagter represented the Council during the closing ceremonies and Mass.

Dine-Out On Saturday, May 21st, the monthly Dine Out was held at Olive Garden on Sand Lake. We had a great turn out: 24 Knights and their guests. Part of the draw might have been that one of our Seminarians, Papdoc, was scheduled to be in Orlando and planned to come to our Dine-Out. Unfortunately, as he was preparing to leave the Seminary for the trip here, he tested positive for Covid. That ended any thoughts of being with us for dinner, as he was quarantined! That didn't seem to inhibit anyone at the table – food disappeared just like it always does. In June there will not be a Dine-out as we will be holding the Annual Awards Dinner on June 11 (see article later in this Vessel). Dine-out will resume in July at Longhorn's Steak House on Orange Blossom Trail.

Memorial Golf McTournament – April 23rd

Final figures were not in as of our May General meeting, but the preliminary results were that we made a profit of \$7,400. That would make it possibly the most successful fundraiser in recent history. Again – great job done by the Council, led by PGK Joe Clark!!
