

The project team completed the following tasks:

Set up drop cloths, wooden horses, several power hand sanders and mixed several gallons of primer paint to be applied to porch posts.

Rough sanded 6-12', 12-10', and 6-4' wood porch posts (6" x 6"). Filled in all defects then fine sanded posts to high quality finish for future installation at new home construction sites.

Applied two coats of primer paint to all porch posts. All posts stored on an open trailer at the Depot for drying. Posts to be transported to Habitat's new construction project



Catechism Corner

The Seven Sacraments – Part 2

The sacraments of Christian Initiation (*Baptism*, *Confirmation and Holy Eucharist*) were discussed in the last rendition of *Catechism Corner*. The remaining sacraments are addressed below.

Penance and Reconciliation is the Sacrament of spiritual healing for a baptized person - from the distancing from God resulting from sins committed. It involves four elements: contrition for one's sins, confession to a priest with the faculty to hear confessions, absolution by the priest, and satisfaction (penance).

Anointing of the Sick (Extreme Unction, or one of the Last Rites) is a Sacrament administered to Catholics who are seriously ill or in danger of death. Its intent is to strengthen the recipient, both spiritually and physically. The other Last Rites are Confession (if the dying person is physically unable to confess, then conditional absolution is given, based on the existence of contrition) and Holy Eucharist (Viaticum, when dying).

Holy Orders is a sacrament by which a man is made a priest, bishop or a deacon. Ordination of a priest confers upon him the power to celebrate the Sacraments and other liturgical acts, especially the Eucharist. Ordination as a bishop confers upon him the fullness of the sacrament, making the bishop a member of the body of successors to the Apostles, and charging him with the mission to teach, govern and sanctify.

Matrimony is the Sacrament that establishes a permanent and exclusive bond between spouses, sealed by God. Accordingly, a marriage between baptized persons, validly entered into and consummated, cannot be dissolved.

Recall that through the sacraments, divine life is bestowed upon us. And so, frequent reception of the sacraments of *Penance & Reconciliation* and *Holy Eucharist* is encouraged.
