

Michael Joseph McGivney

August 12, 1852 - August 14, 1890

Michael McGivney was an American <u>Catholic</u> priest based in <u>New Haven, Connecticut</u>. He founded the <u>Knights of Columbus</u> at a local parish to serve as a mutual aid and <u>insurance</u> organization, particularly for immigrants and their families. It developed through the 20th century as the world's largest Catholic fraternal organization.

The cause for his <u>canonization</u> started in the <u>Archdiocese of Hartford</u> in 1996; in March 2008, <u>Pope Benedict XVI</u> declared McGivney "Venerable" in recognition of his "heroic virtue". On May 27, 2020, <u>Pope Francis</u> announced that McGivney had been approved for beatification, which officially occurred on October 31, 2020.

Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael J. McGivney

God, our Father, protector of the poor and defender of the widow and orphan, you called your priest, Blessed Michael J. McGivney, to be an apostle of Christian family life and to lead the young to the generous service of their neighbor. Through the example of his life and virtue may we follow your Son, Jesus Christ, more closely, fulfilling his commandment of charity and building up his Body which is the Church.

Let the inspiration of your servant prompt us to greater confidence in your love so that we may continue his work of caring for the needy and the outcast. We humbly ask that you glorify Blessed Michael J. McGivney on earth according to the design of your holy will. Through his intercession, grant the favor I now present (here make your request).
