Family of the Year

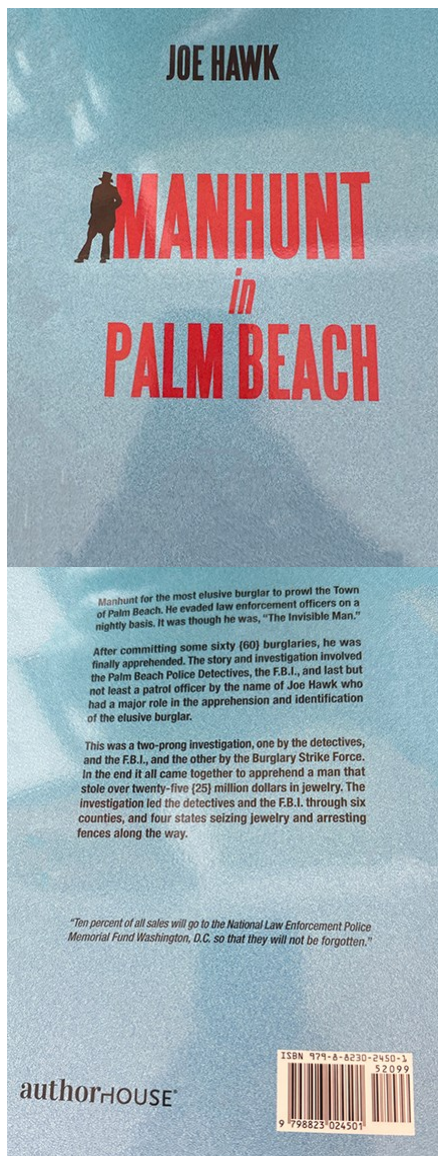

This is a case that he worked on when he was with the Sherriff Office. He describes all the work and effort all of the agencies did to finally bring down this elusive burglar.

Manhunt for the most elusive burglar to prowls the Town of Palm Beach. He evaded law enforcement officers on a nightly basis. It was though he was, "The Invisible Man."

After committing some sixty (60) burglaries, he was finally apprehended. The story and investigation involved the Palm Beach Police Detectives, the F.B.I., and last but not least a patrol officer by the name of Joe Hawk who had a major role in the apprehension and identification of the elusive burglar.

This was a two-prong investigation, one by the detectives, and the F.B.I., and the other by the Burglary Strike Force. In the end it all came together to apprehend a man that stole over twenty-five (25) million dollars in jewelry. The investigation led the detectives and the F.B.I. through six counties, and four states seizing jewelry and arresting fences along the way.

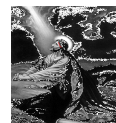
