In addition, our own Michi Davis, also an active fundraiser, received the district's award for completing the most laps. These funds were used to help purchase a second ultrasound machine to be used in Brevard County. The use of ultrasound machines has been found to be an effective tool in preventing the loss of unborn life through abortion.



Our Council's Mardi Gras and Lenten fish dinners again were a great success by bringing hundreds of parishioners and friends together. We cooked, served, broke bread and fish and had a wonderful time while providing needed funds for our parish school at HNJ. Special thanks go out to BK Rod Holzworth, SK Vince Greco, and SK Joe Mayer who oversaw the menu selections, food purchases, and preparation of the food. And a heartfelt thanks to the many volunteers who set up and cleaned the dining area, cooked, and served the food and drinks.
