



### **APRIL – MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND DIVINE MERCY**



The month of April is dedicated to the Holy Spirit, usually in conjunction with the Easter season, the Pascal Mystery and the Resurrection. The month of April is also dedicated to the Holy Eucharist, which is the sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ. In those years where Easter does not occur in April, the month of April is rather unremarkable, totally devoid of holydays. The only major feast in this April is Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, the second Sunday after Easter. Earth Day, April 22, might be considered a close second in popularity.

Three notable canonical feast days in April include St. George, April 23rd - the patron saint of England, St. Mark the Evangelist, April 25th - the author of the Gospel of Mark, and St. Catherine of Siena, April 29th - mystic, theologian, and doctor of the Church.



## Hands and Feet


