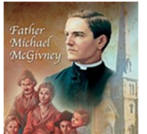

Some quotes from Mother Teresa

8. "Many people are concerned with children of India, with the children of Africa where quite a few die of hunger, and so on. Many people are also concerned about the violence in this great country of the United States. These concerns are very good. But often these same people are not concerned with the millions being killed by the deliberate decision of their own mothers. And this is the greatest destroyer of peace today—abortion which brings people to such blindness."

9. "We must remember that life begins at home and we must also remember that the future of humanity passes through the family."

10. "How do we persuade a woman not to have an abortion? As always, we must persuade her with love and we remind ourselves that love means to be willing to give until it hurts."

Abortion doesn't just affect a mother or even a mother and her child. It affects the father. It affects other children the mother may have or has already birthed. It will have inter-generational affects upon an entire family. Mother Teresa understood this and conversely proclaimed the fact that that every child deserves a chance at life. If denied this God-given right, all of society will suffer.
