Dear brothers in Christ,

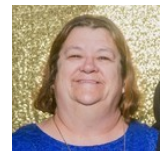

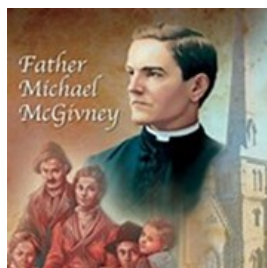

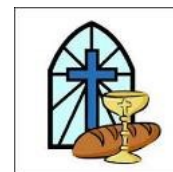
1st Friday Mass Requests

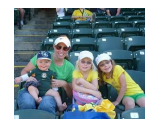

Silver Rose History

The Silver Rose is a Catholic tradition and pilgrimage that honors Our Lady of Guadalupe and promotes the Knights of Columbus. The program involves Knights of Columbus councils carrying eight silver roses across North America from Canada to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico, from early March to mid-December each year.

The pilgrimage includes prayer services and events that promote respect for life, spiritual renewal, and the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The roses travel through the western, central, and eastern corridors of North America, stopping at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe on her feast day, December 12.

The Silver Rose tradition began in 1960 with the Knights of Columbus' Columbian Squires youth organization. The first rose was made from silver, one of Mexico's precious metals, and blessed by Bishop Alfonso Espino Silva.
