

Culture of LIFE November 2022

Hi, my name is Katie Yarborough (parents are CTK Parishioners), a junior at the University of Florida. I am Chair of Respect Life Ministry at Catholic Gators and president of Students for Life, a pro-life club on the UF campus. We pray rosaries in front the local abortion clinic and hold pro-life events for the students of Catholic Gators. Last year, we sponsored 35 students to Washington, D.C. for the March for Life.

This year, I am organizing a combined trip of Students for Life and Catholic Gators to the March for Life in D.C. These young college students are looking to stand up for life in a visible and bold way. This opportunity to march has the potential to change lives and will have a tremendous impact on each student while making a powerful statement to the rest of the nation that we are committed to protecting life from the moment of conception until natural death.

At this time, we are fundraising to help cut the cost for college students to attend so that it will not be a financial burden. At the moment, we expect the cost of the trip to be about \$400 per student, and there are about 50 students interested in going.
