## Deacons Report



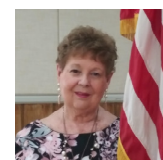
Brothers in Christ,

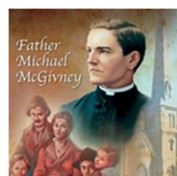

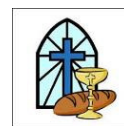
### 1st Friday Mass Requests

## Culture of LIFE June 2022
