

## Culture of LIFE September 2021

On the second anniversary of Roe v. Wade, January 22, 1975, an agency was started in Riverside with a bank balance of \$617.84. **Emergency Pregnancy Services, (EPS)**. As of 2021, the EPS team of six women, with a combined 62 years of serving, counsels moms in crisis pregnancies. EPS client/patient staff consists of two Client Specialists and three Patient Advocates/counselors/ sonographers. The closest office for Arlington is 6903 Merrill Rd. which was added in 2008.

In 2020 they added a **BrightCourse** parent-education program. This new program provides classes in parenting for moms, and dads who would like to learn about caring for their babies.

"BrightCourse includes lessons on pregnancy, infancy, toddlers, parenting, life skills, and more; and we are adding to this list with brand new lessons every month!

BrightCourse lessons are accessible and real. The scripts and content are written at an eighth-grade reading comprehension level to allow for easy digestion. The videos include interviews with peers and experts alike and stories that bring the viewer inside the content. In short, BrightCourse is made for real people." <https://www.brightcourse.com/bc/default.aspx>

Moms who sign up for BrightCourse automatically participate in an Earn While You Learn program wherein, they earn "Mommy Money" to spend on brand new baby items. Upon graduation, thanks to our very generous benefactors, EPS presents each mom with a brand-new Pack and Play to keep baby rested and safe.
