Busy year, important to start 2025 strong; fortunately, got the Columbian Year off to a strong start. There's changes in State Officers: Rich Dahn, new State Treasurer; Marc Anderson, new Charities Director; and Bob Rasch, resigning as Advocate.

We need to get ready to vote for Delegates to the State Convention, beginning in January with the deadline on March 31. FS must register the candidates before they can register. Each council votes for two delegates - one preferably the Grand Knight – and two alternates. The Convention will be held in Jacksonville on

Memorial Day Weekend. Major upcoming events include the Laps for Life Cocktail Party on Saturday, Jan 11 and Casino Night on Saturday, Feb. 28, both at Our Lady of Hope.

Our next Cor meeting will be on Tuesday, Jan 28, at 6:30 pm at Our Lady of Hope, then Feb. 25 at Sacred Heart. The March meeting will be Tuesday, March 18 at Our Lady of Hope, with March 25 reserved for the big FAITH gathering at OLOH. Cor is open to all Catholic men over 18 – a great opportunity to learn more about our Catholic faith.

We're off to a great recruiting year – ranked second in the state at the beginning of November, now down to fourth. OLOH has already achieved two-star – 30 doubling the goal of 15, and Sacred Heart has Star Council, meeting its goal of nine. Epiphany Council has three of its goal of seven.

On the Fourth Degree side, the 125th anniversary will be Feb. 22 in New York City with a mass at St. Patrick's and a banquet at the Manhattan Hilton. The new ceremony is open to friends and family. First time for the new degree in Florida is tentatively Saturday, April 26 in Bradenton.
