If they do, they will be banned from speaking to any of our parish groups, per Fr. Matt. And your group may lose its vetting privileges. This is a Diocesan requirement." (In our case the GK, or DGK has approval authority, so please inform me *prior* to any guest speakers, etc.)

A thought about Revenge - mentioned in both the Old and New Testaments of the Bible. God warned His people to avoid seeking revenge and to let Him avenge them and bring about perfect justice how He saw fit. When we want to retaliate, we should keep in mind that causing another person harm will never undo the harm you have already endured. 



# **Church Has Always Condemned Abortion**

Given the revelation of the Old and New Testaments, with special emphasis on the mystery of the incarnation, the Roman Catholic Church has condemned the practice of abortion. Several examples of teaching which span the first three hundred years of our Church include the following: The "Didache" ("The Teachings of the Twelve Apostles," c. 80 A.D.) asserted, "You shall not procure abortion. You shall not destroy the newborn child." The "Epistle of Barnabas" (138) also condemned abortion. Athenagoras (177) in his "A Plea on Behalf of Christians" (a defense against paganism) emphasized that Christians consider as murderers those women who take medicines to procure an abortion; he condemns the killer of children, including those still living in their mother's womb, "where they are already the object of the care of divine providence." Tertullian, (197) in his "Apologeticum" likewise asserted, "To prevent birth is anticipated murder; it makes little difference whether one destroys a life already born or does away with it in its nascent stage. The one who will be man is already one." In the year 300, the Council of Elvira, a local church council in Spain, passed specific legislation condemning abortion (Canon 63).

After the legalization of Christianity in 313, the condemnation against abortion remained. For instance, St. Basil in a letter to Bishop Amphilochius (374) clearly pronounces the Church's teaching: "A woman who has deliberately destroyed a fetus must pay the penalty for murder" and "Those also who give drugs causing abortions are murderers themselves, as well as those who receive the poison which kills the fetus."

While many other examples could be offered, the key point is that the Roman Catholic Church from the beginning has consistently upheld the sanctity of the life of the unborn child and condemned the act of direct abortion. To oppose this teaching contradicts the revelation of Sacred Scripture and Christian tradition... As Catholic Christians, must pray for a change of heart in all citizens and courageously teach and defend the sanctity of human life, particularly that of the defenseless, innocent unborn children.



# **Faith in Action** Homeless Vets Help

Homeless veterans are eligible for the same disability compensation and pension benefits as other veterans, but the VA also offers specialized programs like the <a href="HUD-VASH">HUD-VASH</a> program for permanent housing, and <a href="Homeless Veterans Community Employment Services">Homeless Veterans Community Employment Services</a> to help with job placement. The VA provides resources and services to help homeless veterans access their earned benefits.

A homeless Veteran can also get their VA disability check by establishing a stable address with the help of the HUD-VASH, contacting the VA's National Call Center for homeless Veterans at 877-424-3838 or establishing a local P.O. Box.
