As you will see if you help at Bingo or go to the meetings, the video system update is **COMPLETE!** Nothing but positive comments by our players as to the quality of the installation. Father Dunne is also very satisfied. The system is also available for use by other ministries as well.

Also included in the hall upgrade project is refurbishment/replacement of kitchen equipment (to be governed under church capital projects). While estimates are being received, the ovens and cooktops, dishwasher, etc., are going to be replaced, **a double fryer is planned for installation.**

Bingo is in a bit of tizzy for April. Due to various church activities, there is **ONLY** one BINGO date in April, that being April 13, Palm Sunday. Doors will Open at 1PM, and first game starts at 2 p.m. (different than every other Sunday). We are back to every Sunday in May and June, with doors opening at noon and first ball called at 1.

Please consider volunteering to help with Bingo. We are looking for additional cooks, as well as an additional caller and cashier. If you can help, even once a month, it allows us to release people who volunteer **WEEK AFTER WEEK.** Please let me know. Again, other than the caller and main cashier, there is very little training that needs be done – like 5 minutes per station.
