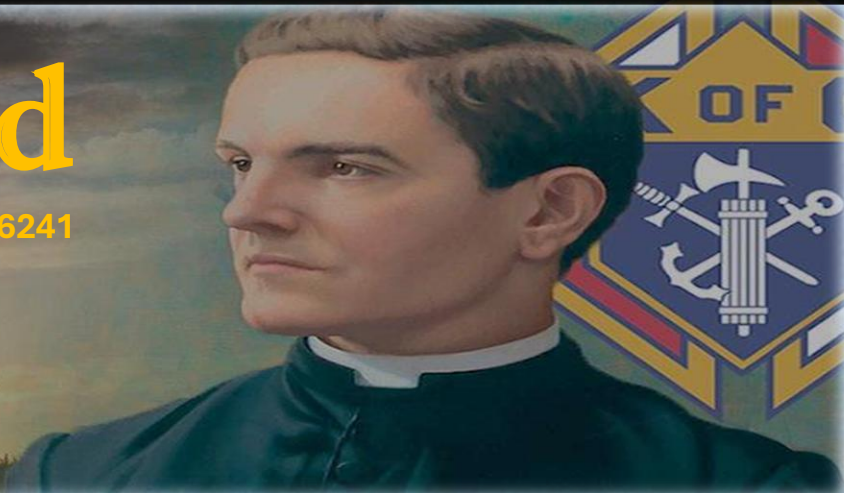
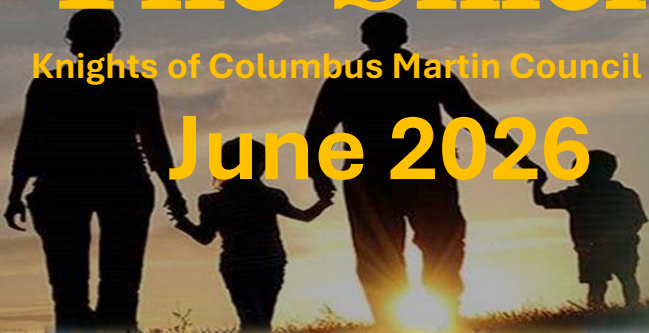


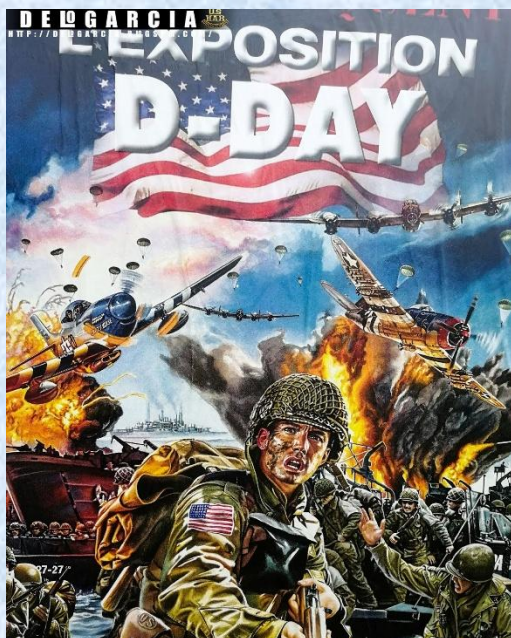

## Bingo Update



Brothers,

While not officially Summer, it is beginning to feel like it. While some of our winter visitors have left, it hasn't been a huge impact on our Bingo attendance. To date, we have averaged an additional 5 players per week over last fiscal year. And thanks to the number of players enjoying the games (and the food we provide at a reasonable cost) and YOUR involvement with Bingo, we have been able to help more with our charities than we have in the last 6 years.

**Bingo will be in full swing every Sunday until fall.**

Bingo doors open at noon on Sunday, and first game starts at 1:00 p.m. The games currently last until 4 to 4:15, so it is not an all-day affair.

Summertime comes with vacations with family. I get that. What we can use is a couple more volunteers. Not every week, just once or twice a month. Many of our brothers have dedicated themselves to helping our charities, and it is appreciated by not only me but our charities as well. But they deserve a bit of a respite. Additionally, I have been challenged at the homefront to reduce my Bingo exposure. Since we started Bingo back up after COVID, I have been there essentially every week. I need to find someone who is a bit Tech savvy, that can learn how the systems (bingo machine, audio, and video) to allow me to drop back a bit. Lacking that help, I will be forced to give up my Knights activities completely. We have expertise and knowledge in the cashier, kitchen, and paper areas, just not in the technical areas.

One of our callers, Walt Adley, is stepping down after 15 years of calling Bingo. While Brother Don Sheetz is currently in training, we would like some new faces to learn to call BINGO. **Please consider volunteering to help with Bingo.** Brother Pasquale Volpe has lightened my load by organizing front table personnel, and **he could use some more brothers** to set up a rotational schedule. Just 1 and a half hours after the 10:30 mass on Sunday at Holy Redeemer. **We would also like to train an additional cashier.** It really isn't that challenging. Lead cashier needs to be there by 10:30 (to ensure they can get a parking spot), assist in setting up the cashier tables with early card sales help. Once the doors open, the lead cashier sells the game packs, and once the games start, divvy out the money for the winners, and is there to close the books when Bingo is over. Card sales can use some help, from 11:30 to 1 (contact Pat Volpe), and afternoon floor help from 1 pm to close. **Thanks to George Fabre, who has volunteered to replace Kevin on the Grill. But that doesn't mean that we are flush with our chefs. If you like to cook, love the smell of hamburgers on the grill, we can keep you busy for an hour and a half. Please let me know or come in at 11:30 (right after the 10:30 mass) and see what is involved.**

All we are asking for is a commitment of a couple of hours per month. While I do sincerely appreciate those gentlemen who come in week after week, I am appealing to our other brother Knights. Please prayerfully consider using some of your time (and talent) to spread charity and goodwill to our biggest charitable event. Please help us keep alive the first pillar of the Knights of Columbus – Charity. Please let me know if you would like to help!

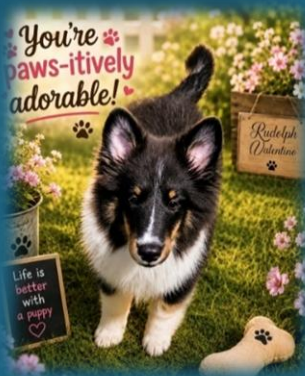

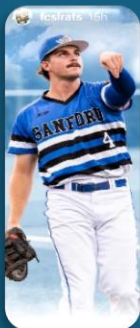
# Members Corner

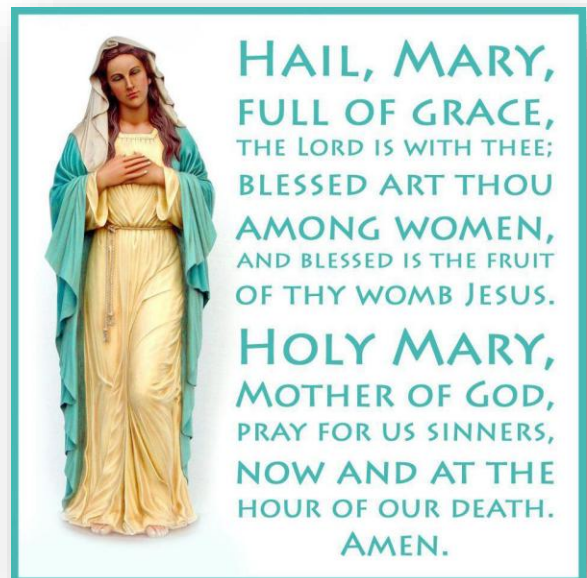
# Culture of Life
