GK Calendar Note- A new sign up application will be deployed for Council 14202, Assembly 3094 and the Columbiettes this Fraternal Year- **SignUp Genius**. We encourage Knights and Columbiettes to get familiar with it for the RSVP and Volunteer hot <u>links above</u> in the calendar. It simplifies both the RSVP and Volunteering for an event and will provide a link for your phone calendar <u>and</u> a reminder email to you two days prior to the event. The application requires you to <u>only</u> enter your <u>name and email</u> and NOT to sign into the application. It is safe, proven effective in volunteer organizations and we strongly encourage its use to help us better plan food for events, track our attendance and manage your volunteering.

ULTRASOUND INITIATIVE PROGRAM

A few items pertaining to the District-wide Ultrasound Initiative Program:

- St. Peter the Apostle Council has scheduled a Dance for October 11, 2025 in their Ballroom that can hold 500 people. They are asking for all Naples councils to help sell tickets to this dance at ALL PARISHES by ALL COUNCILS to try to make that number as close to 500 as possible. All net Proceeds from the Dance and Cash Bar will go to this Ultrasound Program. Look for an advertisement in the St. Agnes Bulletin at a future time closer to the event to purchase event tickets online.
- 2. A Restricted KCCF Fund has been set up for the event and Donors can go to this site and donate and **receive a Tax Deduction**.
- 3. Also for private donors, this is a Restricted Fund so that Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) can be made to it from Traditional IRAs as Charitable Rollovers satisfying a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) while also offering tax benefits. Below you will find all the information I have for donations into the fund.
- 4. St. Agnes Council will be repeating its Parish Baby Bottle Drive in November 2025. Council 14202 has voted that the net proceeds from that drive will also go to the Ultrasound Program.
